Pianist Carl Blake is Director of Music at The Church for the Fellowship of All Peoples in San Francisco. He possesses three degrees in music: Bachelor of Arts *magna cum laude* from Boston University, Master of Arts from San Jose State University and Doctor of Musical Arts from Cornell University. He is a two-time recipient of the Fulbright Scholar Award and is the first recipient of the Marian Anderson Young Artist Award presented by Ms. Anderson herself. Dr. Blake has performed to national and international acclaim in such venues as Carnegie Recital Hall (currently re-named Weill Recital Hall), Wigmore Hall (London) and L'Hermitage (Winter Place of the Czars, St. Petersburg, Russia). As Artistic Ambassador under the auspices of the United States Department of State, Blake presented recitals in many countries and geographical regions such as the Caribbean Islands, Mexico, Central America and South America. Mr. Blake currently resides and teaches private piano in Oakland, California.
